Our residential program services children from birth to age 21, who have been removed from their homes due to abuse, neglect, or abandonment. We provide a variety of services which meet the social, educational, medical, and psychological needs of each child. Our primary focus is to keep sibling groups together in a safe, stable, and nurturing environment until a more permanent placement can be provided.



WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE

Residential Care

We provide a variety of services which meet the social, educational, medical, and psychological needs of each child.

Education Program

Our onsite education programs offer a safe and non-judgmental place for children to learn while they are in care. We have an onsite Hillsborough County Classroom for grades K - 5th which provides a smaller classroom setting for children who are with us for a short period of time or need more one on one academic attention. We now have a classroom where our school age children conduct weekly inquiries, long term investigations, and learn science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics skills. In Ms. Alice's lab, students have the opportunity to learn these concepts but also apply them doing hands on activities. We also have a computer lab for virtual school, college classes and for our teens who want to apply for jobs. We offer tutoring and small study groups after school to focus on areas of academic improvement for all of children.

House Parent Model

A Kid's Place is based on a live-in House Parent model that allows brothers and sisters to live on-site with House Parents who provide a healthy and nurturing home.

Independent Living

With our Independent Living Program, youth participate in various training to include: personal health and hygiene, basic cooking and cleaning, financial literacy, employment, and volunteering.

Extended Foster Care

Our Extended Foster Care Program is a home for residents ages 18-22 and are transitioning from residential care into an independent living setting. This home allows the resident to live on their own and have connections with their sibling(s) who may reside in our traditional residential setting on campus.

EDUCATION

With the change in population of our children at A Kid's Place, we needed to reevaluate our resources.

We now have a classroom where our school age children conduct weekly inquiries, long term investigations, and learn science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics skills.

In Ms. Alice's lab, students have the opportunity to learn these concepts but also apply them doing hands on activities.

We offer afterschool homework labs in our classrooms with guided help from Ms. Cathy and Ms. Alice for Kindergarten through fifth grade.

We offer afterschool tutoring 5 days a week with Ms. Nancy who works with our middle and high school students in their specific skill areas of need.

EXTENDED FOSTER CARE

Now that children are aging out of care with us, it is important for us to be able to offer them support during their next phase of life.

Our Extended Foster Care home is a home for residents who turned 18 and are transitioning from residential care into an independent living setting to learn to live on their own. This home allows the resident to have connections with their sibling(s) who may reside in our traditional residential setting on campus.
