A Kid's Place provides a safe, loving, and nurturing home for foster children. Our residential program serves children from birth to age 18, who have been removed from their homes due to abuse, neglect, or abandonment. We provide a variety of services which meet the social, educational, medical, and psychological needs of each child. Our primary focus is to keep sibling groups together in a safe, stable, and nurturing environment until a more permanent placement can be provided. In 2020 we added a 6th home for young adults, ages 18-22, aging out of foster care.

We emphasize stability and normalcy, our approach leads to positive outcomes—from family reunification to improvements in physical, mental, and socioemotional health—for the children we serve. The keys to our success include:

Residential Care

Brothers and sisters live together in one of five on-campus homes with "live-in" house parents trained in Trauma-Informed Care. Family-style meals, adventures, excursions, support at school events, and celebrations provide a loving, normal existence and foster meaningful family engagement, which is integral to the healing process.

Individualized Care Plans

Internal and external case managers work together with House Parents, staff, and licensed professionals to create step-by-step plans to improve the physical, mental, and social-emotional health of each child, according to their needs.

House Parent Model

A Kid's Place is based on a live-in House Parent Model that allows brothers and sisters to live on-site with house parents who provide a healthy and nurturing home. Family style meals, outings, support at school functions, medical appointments, and other day to day activities provide a loving and normal existence to foster children.

Independent Living

With our Independent Living Program, youth participate in various training to include: personal health and hygiene, basic cooking and cleaning, financial literacy, employment, and volunteering.

Extended Foster Care

Just because a child turns 18 doesn't mean they are able to achieve stability and success on their own. That's why we added a sixth home to serve 18- to 22-year-olds. At our Independent Living House, young adults live semi-independently near their younger siblings and get help developing the life and job skills they need to transition to full independence.

From immunizations, medical and dental care to behavioral therapy and tutoring, we partner with licensed care providers to care for children holistically. We also provide targeted, developmentally appropriate programs for children of different ages, including:

A satellite Hillsborough County classroom for children in grades K–5 that offers a small classroom setting and provides individual attention by a Hillsborough County teacher, allowing these children to thrive and better enable them to succeed once they return to mainstream public school.

An Independent Living Program, designed to equip teens with the life skills they need - from cooking nutritious meals to exploring careers with guest speakers from local businesses and trades.






