Purchased a second home to support our House Parent model and AKP reached our \$300K endowment goal and received matching funds from the Community Foundation of Tampa Bay in the amount of \$100,000.

Became a member of the Florida Coalition for Children. Cared for over 1,380 children.

♥ 2018

Invested \$1M for long-term sustainability and expanded Independent Living classes for Young Adults.

Became accredited by CARF International.

Opened an Extended Foster Care Home for children aging out at age 18.

♥ 2021

Opened AKP Thrift and helped 2 young adults purchase their first car.

♥ 2022

A Kid's Place has cared for over 1,624 children.

*A Kid's Place provides a safe, loving, and nurturing home for foster children. Our residential program serves children from birth to age 18, who have been removed from their homes due to abuse, neglect, or abandonment. We provide a variety of services which meet the social, educational, medical, and psychological needs of each child. Our primary focus is to keep sibling groups together in a safe, stable, and nurturing environment until a more permanent placement can be provided. In 2021 we added a 6th home for young adults, ages 18-22, aging out of foster care.*

Dottie dedicated her life to children in need. A passionate advocate for children, she left her footprint throughout the Tampa Bay area. From 2005–2009 she worked tirelessly to develop, create and co-found A Kid's Place, a residential group home that safely shelters sibling groups in foster care.

# WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE

**WHAT SETS A KID'S PLACE OF TAMPA BAY APART IS OUR COMMITMENT TO PROVIDING MORE THAN A SAFE PLACE TO LIVE.**



## HOUSE PARENT MODEL

A Kid's Place is based on a live-in House Parent Model that allows brothers and sisters to live on-site with house parents who provide a healthy and nurturing home. Family style meals, outings, support at school functions, medical appointments, and other day to day activities provide a loving and normal existence to foster children.



## EXTENDED FOSTER CARE

Just because a child turns 18 doesn't mean they are able to achieve stability and success on their own. That's why we added a sixth home to serve 18- to 22-year-olds. At our Independent Living Home, young adults live semi-independently near their younger siblings and get help developing the life and job skills they need to transition to full independence.

## ACADEMIC PLANS

Individualized academic plans cater to each child's unique needs, strengths, and goals. With help from our on-site teachers and tutors we can provide diverse learning styles and paces, allowing each child in our care to have the tools they need for personal growth, and academic success.

## INDIVIDUALIZED CARE PLANS

Internal and external case managers work together with House Parents, staff, and licensed professionals to create step-by-step plans to improve the physical, mental, and social-emotional health of each child, according to their needs.

## INDEPENDENT LIVING

With our Independent Living Program, youth participate in various training to include: personal health and hygiene, basic cooking and cleaning, financial literacy, employment, and volunteering.



# CHANGING LIVES DAILY COMPREHENSIVE, ACCESSIBLE SERVICES



- From immunizations, medical and dental care to behavioral therapy, we partner with licensed care providers to care for children holistically. We also provide targeted, developmentally appropriate programs for children of different ages, including:
- A satellite Hillsborough County classroom for children in grades K–5 that offers a small classroom setting and provides individual attention by a Hillsborough County teacher, allowing these children to thrive and better enable them to succeed once they return to mainstream public school. Our Academic Supervisor ensures every child has an academic plan for success.
- The Stepping Stones Independent Living Program is designed to equip teens with the life skills they need – from cooking nutritious meals to exploring careers with guest speakers from local businesses and trades.
- In 2021, we expanded services with an extended foster home for young adults ages 18–22.
- In 2023, we added on-site therapy for our children, which provides them with consistent, accessible mental health support; helping them process trauma, build trust, and develop emotional resilience, which is critical for their overall well-being and future stability.
