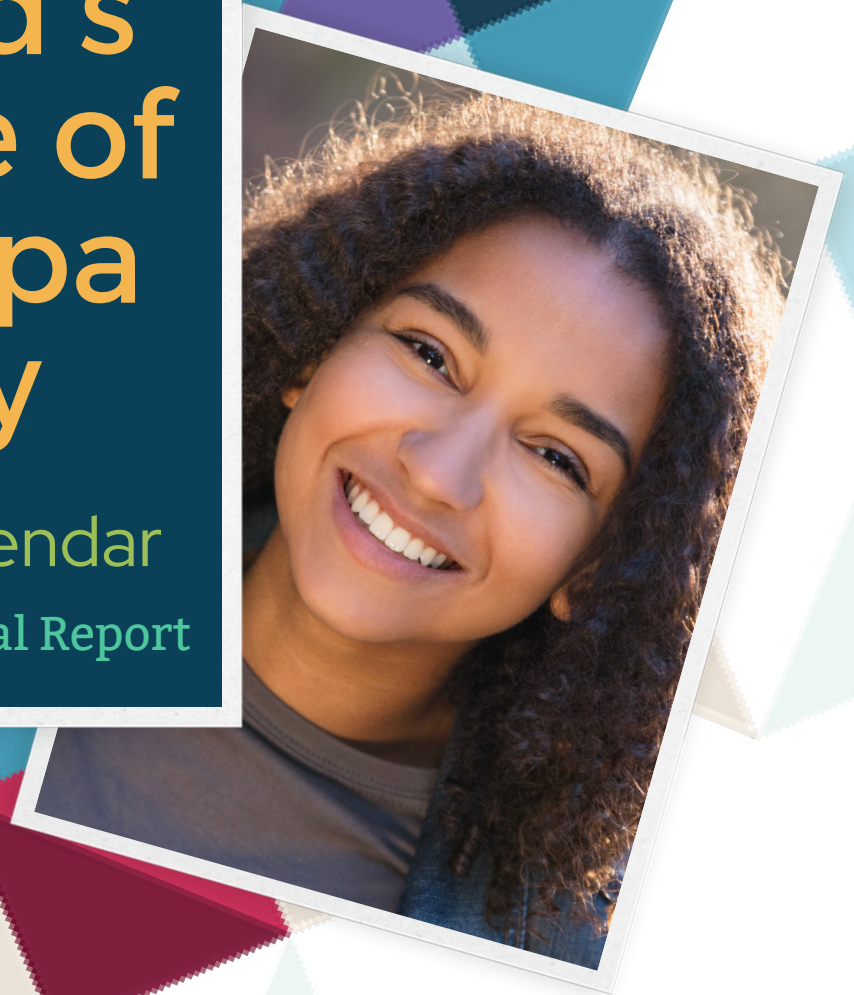

WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE

PROVIDING MORE THAN A SAFE PLACE TO LIVE

ACADEMIC PLANS

Individualized academic plans cater to each child's unique needs, strengths, and goals. With help from our on-site teachers and tutors we can provide diverse learning styles and paces, allowing each child in our care to have the tools they need for personal growth, and academic success.

EXTENDED FOSTER CARE

Just because a child turns 18 doesn't mean they are able to achieve stability and success on their own. That's why we added a second home to serve 18- to 23-year-olds. At our Independent Living Homes, young adults live semi-independently near their younger siblings and get help developing the life and job skills they need to transition to full independence.

HOUSE PARENT MODEL

A Kid's Place is based on a live-in House Parent Model that allows brothers and sisters to live on-site with house parents who provide a healthy and nurturing home. Family style meals, outings, support at school functions, medical appointments, and other day to day activities provide a loving and normal existence to foster children.

INDIVIDUALIZED CARE PLANS

Internal and external case managers work together with House Parents, staff, and licensed professionals to create step-by-step plans to improve the physical, mental, and social-emotional health of each child, according to their needs.



INDEPENDENT LIVING

With our Independent Living Program, youth participate in various training to include: personal health and hygiene, basic cooking and cleaning, financial literacy, employment, and volunteering.

CHANGING LIVES DAILY

COMPREHENSIVE, ACCESSIBLE SERVICES

From immunizations, medical and dental care to behavioral therapy, we partner with licensed care providers to care for children holistically. We also provide targeted, developmentally appropriate programs for children of different ages, including:

- ♥ A satellite Hillsborough County classroom for children in grades K–5 that offers a small classroom setting and provides individual attention by a Hillsborough County teacher, allowing these children to thrive and better enable them to succeed once they return to mainstream public school. Our Academic Supervisor ensures every child has an academic plan for success.
- ♥ We offer on-site therapy for our children, which provides them with consistent, accessible mental health support; helping them process trauma, build trust, and develop emotional resilience, which is critical for their overall well-being and future stability.

CELEBRATING OUR BIG & SMALL WINS

HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2024-25

- ♥ Purchased property to expand programming.
- ♥ Opened a second extended foster care home that serves young adults ages 18 - 23.
- ♥ Expanded the team by adding an Academic Supervisor and Unit Secretary in support of our Direct Care Teams, who work directly with our children.
- ♥ Updated and renovated onsite classroom to be more age inclusive.
- ♥ Completed campus renovations of new roofs, AC's and windows.
- ♥ Implemented Trauma Informed model ICARE, Child Adult Relationship Enhancement.
- ♥ Welcomed three new Board members.



GEARING UP FOR SCHOOL

HELPING OUR KIDS SUCCEED AT AKP

A KID'S PLACE WENT FROM:

13 students on AKP honor roll to 21 students.

Expansion of awards and recognition includes: consistency, advocacy, and advancement to recognize our students in the GED program.



OUR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS ARE DESIGNED TO IMPROVE AND ENHANCE OUR STUDENTS' OVERALL PERFORMANCE IN THE CLASSROOM.

Students are afforded the opportunity to participate in tutoring, study support groups, and organizational groups. Although the programs are new, they have had a tremendous impact on our students' academic success thus far. Our tutor has seen students who were struggling academically last year excel this year. Academic improvement is one of the goals of these programs along with bolstering our students' confidence in their skill sets, building relationships with peers, and learning how to advocate and communicate their needs.

FOR OUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS:

There was a 20% increase in the number of students passing math.

FOR OUR MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:

The overall number of F's on report cards decreased by 9.5%

A's increased by 9.85% for middle and high school students.

AGING OUT OF FOSTER CARE SHOULDN'T MEAN AGING OUT OF SUPPORT

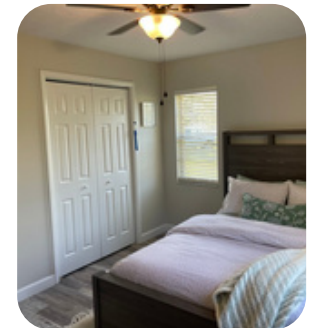
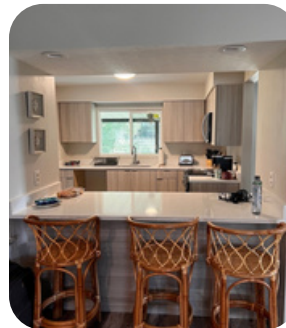
At A Kid's Place, we're proud to offer additional services for young adults ages 18–23, a vital next step for those who are transitioning from residential care to living independently.

We offer two dedicated homes to serve young adults who have aged out of foster care, providing a safe, structured space where they can explore independence and learn through experience with guidance every step of the way.

To participate in this program they have to be enrolled in college, a trade school or working.

Living in a designated EFC home gives young adults the space to:

- ♥ Take ownership of their daily responsibilities
- ♥ Manage their own schedules and decisions
- ♥ Practice their budgeting and self-care
- ♥ Prepare their meals and maintain their space
- ♥ Learn from their mistakes in a safe, supportive setting

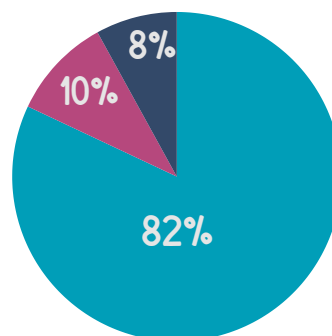

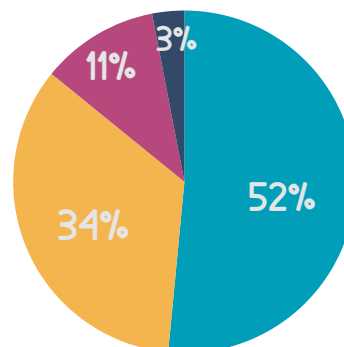

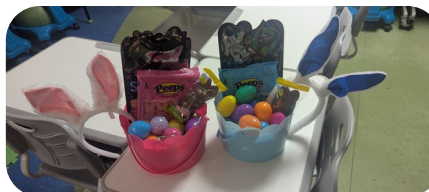
